## Some of the services we provide from the Westfield Centre

**Children's Day Care** Monday to Friday between 7.30am and 6pm. We offer quality care in a safe, secure and stimulating environment where all staff are qualified to level 3 and above and have specialist areas of work. For further information or to register your child please contact us.

**Play Group sessions** from 0 to 5 years, every Monday and Friday between 9am and 11am, costs £1.00 per person and includes morning snacks and structured activities

**Summer Play Scheme** starts on Monday 7th August 2017 and will run for four weeks. You need to register your child for which days they will be attending. The scheme costs £5.00 per child per day and sessions start at 10.30am to 2.30pm. There is a wide variety of activities planned. Please contact us for the timetable of activities

**Children's Parties** we have a varied range of parties from Bouncy Castle Parties, Fancy Dress Parties, Soft Play Parties, Bounce and Slide Parties, Karaoke Parties, Pop Up Pirate Parties, Pop Up Princess Parties and Space Hopper Parties, all priced at £55.00 (Discount of £5.00 for residents of South Elmsall) with food packages catering for 20 guests priced separately. Extra bolt on items such as Candy Cart, Laser Lights and Smoke Machine are available on request.

**Citizens Advice Bureau** is based at the Westfield Centre every Tuesday between 10am to 1pm. You need to make an appointment by calling into the Westfield Centre on the day of the session – we are open from 8am to take appointments. The advisor helps with matters such as debt, homelessness, welfare and benefit advice and bereavement assistance.

**Food Bank** operates from the Westfield Centre every Friday between 10am to 2pm you should be issued with a voucher to use the service. Vouchers can be issued from WDH, Turning Point, Doctors Surgery, Citizens Advice Bureau, Jon Trickett MP and Social Workers.

**Electricity and Gas Vouchers** can be obtained from the Westfield Centre but you must provide evidence of your bank statements as well as photographic evidence of your Electric/Gas meters.

**CV Help** is available at the Westfield Centre by appointment only. Job searching and other support is available. Please call us for further information.

**Garden Scheme** is available for any resident over the age of 65 or who is registered disabled. Your garden will need assessing before you can be accepted on to the scheme. The garden service operates between the months of April to September each year.

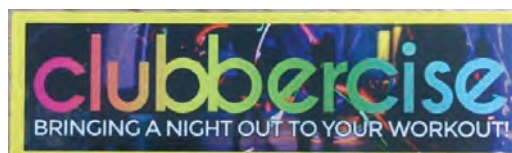
